Eligibility

Entries are open to amateur golfers who (1) were a female at birth, (2) maintain a residence in Ohio, (3) are members of and have a regular membership at a Private Club in Ohio which has paid 2009 W.O.S.G.A. membership dues, (4) who have a current USGA Handicap index not exceeding 25.0, if a member of a Member Club, (5) or, if not a member of a Private Club in Ohio which has paid 2009 W.O.S.G.A. membership dues, who have a current USGA Handicap index not exceeding 22.0, and (6) have reached their 50th birthday by July 20, 2009.

The field will be limited to 60 players. A player's eligibility from a handicap standpoint will depend on her handicap in effect on the date she filed entry. Later vacancies in the field will be offered to alternates in the order of handicaps. Any tie in the highest acceptable handicap class or for an alternate's position will be settled by lot.

Entries are subject to rejection at any time (including during the Championship) by the W.O.S.G.A. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

Entries: Form, Fee

All players shall apply on W.O.S.G.A. entry forms, or copy thereof, obtainable from the W.O.S.G.A., W.O.S.G.A. Member Clubs or from the W.O.S.G.A. website. (*Entry form is attached. Please detach before sending. Keep this page for your own use.*)

Entry fee of \$150.00 shall be paid by every player who is a member of a private club. Entry fee of \$160.00 shall be paid by every player who is a Publinx player. Entry fee will be refunded, regardless of reason, if Mary Mazingo, the Tournament Director (330-644-0867), is notified before the close of entries. After the entry deadline, the entry fee will be refunded subject to a service charge. An entry fee paid by any alternate not accepted into the tournament will be refunded in full.

Entry fee includes cart fee for the practice round and two days of tournament play, Monday dinner, Tuesday lunch, on course snacks, range balls and prizes.

Entry Deadline

Entries close July 9, 2009, subject to acceptance by the W.O.S.G.A. Executive Committee. Entries of members of dues paying clubs shall have priority acceptance until July 1, 2009. No entries taken at the tee. Acknowledgment of acceptance of entry will be mailed or, preferably, e-mailed.

Rules of Golf; Close of Competition

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. Questions shall be settled by the W.O.S.G.A. Executive Committee, whose decision shall be final. The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the Championship Trophy has been presented or when all scores have been approved by the Committee.

Schedule

The Championship will be a 36 hole stroke play event.
Sunday, July 19 - Practice Round, starting at 12:00 P.M. from #1 tee. Range and Pro Shop will open all day.
Monday, July 20 - First round, 18 holes, tee times beginning at 8:30 A.M. from hole #1.
Tuesday, July 21 - Second round, 18 holes, 8:30 A.M. shotgun.

The competitor with the lowest score for 36 holes will be the Champion.

Ties: In the event of a tie for the lowest score for the Championship, the winner shall be determined immediately by a sudden death playoff. All other ties shall be broken by comparison of the score cards.

Practice Privileges

Practice rounds will be scheduled for Sunday, July 19. Please indicate your preference for your practice round time on your entry.

Flights, Prizes

Flights shall be determined by handicap. Handicaps will be verified. Prizes shall be awarded for each flight, based on a two day gross score, at the completion of play on the second day.

Registration at Greene Country Club

Registration will be held between 11 A.M. and 2 P.M. on Sunday, July 19, 2009. Players must register in person.

Players' Dinner

The W.O.S.G.A. invites all players to a reception and dinner at Greene Country Club on Monday, July 20.

Contestants are guests of the W.O.S.G.A.

Players' Closing Luncheon

Prizes will be awarded at the closing luncheon on Tuesday, July 21, 2009.

Footwear

It is a condition of the competition that shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this rule: *Disqualification.*

Golf Balls; Equipment

Only brands of golf balls on the most current *USGA List of Conforming Golf Balls* shall be used. The player's clubs shall conform with the *The Rules of Golf.*

Penalty for breach of this rule: *Disqualification.*

Time of Starting

The optional condition for time of starting as prescribed in Appendix I of the Rules of Golf, shall be in effect.

Lockers will be available. Bag storage is recommended for Monday evening.

Conditions; Schedules

The W.O.S.G.A. Executive Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the Executive Committee in any matter shall be final.

Caddies; Automotive Transportation

Automotive transportation is required.

Cell Phones, Pagers, and Beepers

Players are not to use these devices on the golf course. Repeated offenses will be dealt with under Rule 33-7.

Electronic Measuring Devices

The local rule permitting these devices is *NOT* in effect, but they may be used during the practice round.

Substitutions

If a player withdraws prior to or on the first day of the Championship, prior to playing her first stroke, substitution is allowable. A list of alternates shall be maintained by the W.O.S.G.A.
