Policy No: 2018-01, ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF RISK

Purpose: Volunteer at your own risk

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By volunteering at a Women's Ohio State Golf Association (WOSGA) event, the volunteer and any spectators/guests associated with the volunteer understands and agrees that there are known risks involved with the participation in/at a golf event, including but not limited to being struck by lightning, being struck by a golf ball or golf club, suffering from heat exhaustion, incurring a severe health problem like a heart attack or stroke, being injured by uneven terrain, being injured while riding in a golf cart or by a golf cart, all of such risks the volunteer assumes and solely accepts, and waves all claims of injury to body or property against the WOSGA. Furthermore, the volunteer agrees that while on the premises of all WOSGA events, the volunteer, any spectators/guests, associated with the volunteer, shall be present at their own risk and that the WOSGA shall not be liable for any claims for injuries or damages whatsoever to person or property of that volunteer or associated person arising out of or in connection with the participation in the WOSGA event or presence at the WOSGA event. The volunteer agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the WOSGA from all claims by or liability to the volunteer and associated persons. **The volunteer has been provided a copy of the 2017-1 Risk Management Policy of the WOSGA and is required to review said Risk Management Policy. In no event shall the WOSGA be liable for any intentional act causing injury to any contestant during the golf event.**
